

Regulated Price Plan Declaration Form 2020

To elect the Time of Use (TOU) or Tiered prices through the Regulated Price Plan (RPP), you must first declare your eligibility.

Pursuant to the Regulation filed under s. 79.4(1) (a) of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, and Ontario Reg. 95/05, the Ontario Government has identified the criteria to determine your eligibility to receive the fixed commodity price (Regulated Price Plan) currently in place in Ontario.

This form is used to notify Peterborough Distribution (1937680 Ontario Inc.) of a customer's eligibility for the Regulated Price Plan according to the regulation.

Step 1 - Does your account qualify?

Customers classed as Residential (single family dwelling), consumers with demand of 50 kilowatts or less or annual consumption of 250,000 kilowatt hours or less, **need not declare** and are enrolled by default in the regulated price plan.

FARM

- A consumer carries on a farming business within the meaning of the Farm Registration and Farm Organizations Funding Act, 1993 and the consumer either holds a valid registration number assigned under the farm registration and Farm Organizations Fund Act, 1993 or the consumers obligation to file a farming business registration form was waived pursuant to an order made under subsection 22 (6) of the Act , and the consumer is not otherwise eligible for treatment under clause 79.16 (1) (b) of the Act with respect to its farming business pursuant to a regulation made under the Act). RESIDENTIAL

- The account relates to a property as defined in the Condominium Act, 1998,
 - The account relates to a residential complex as defined in the Residential Tenancies Act, 2006 Or
 - The account relates to a property that includes one or more dwellings and that is owned or leased by a cooperative as defined in the Co-operative Corporations Act.
- And
- The associated meter services a common area of the complex
- Or
- The associated meter services multiple residential units (bulk metered)
 - A "qualifying unit" is defined as a unit that:*
 - a) consists of a self-contained room or set of rooms,*
 - b) contains kitchen and bathroom facilities that are for the sole use of the unit, and*
 - c) is occupied and used as a residence.*

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Step Two - Fill in the form and Declare

If your account qualifies, please fill in the information below ensuring the information provided matches the details on your invoice. **If you have multiple accounts with Peterborough Distribution (1937680 Ontario Inc.) that qualify then you must list each qualifying account on its own separate form.**

It is important to submit the necessary information to our office as soon as possible as forms received will be eligible for the Regulated Price Plan on future bills only and will not be adjusted retroactively. In addition, we will not adjust previous billings due to delays in processing that are a result of missing or inaccurate information on the form.
