Overview

The PTBO H₂O water station can provide municipal tap water at your summer event. The accessible mobile station has 8 water fountains and 8 water bottle refill station. Event patrons can have drink or fill up their bottles with refreshing cold tap water.

Since 1914 Peterborough Utilities has been providing safe, reliable, cost-effective production and delivery of consistently high-quality water – from source to your home's tap! And now, get the same water on the go! Take your water bottle with you and fill up at the PTBO H₂O Mobile Drinking Water Station at outdoor community events throughout the city in the summer months.

The PTBO H₂O Mobile Drinking Water Station serve as a fun and practical way to educate people about one of our most valuable resources — drinking water.

The water for the City of Peterborough meets or exceeds the government's requirements for water testing. Our staff conduct more than 20,000 tests a year to ensure your drinking water is of the highest quality – more tests than government regulations require. We conduct tests annually, quarterly, weekly and there are even some that run continuously. We perform on-going facility maintenance, and constantly upgrade and improve our water infrastructure including Peterborough's water treatment plant. The water used in the PTBO H₂O Mobile Drinking Water Station will be the same great water.

Booking

Events with an interested in booking the PTBO H₂O Mobile Drinking Water Station are asked to submit their requests 3 weeks in advance of the date of the event. Requests submitted less than 3 weeks prior to the event will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

To submit your request, please ensure:

- The event is held between the months of May through August. Beyond this time window, due to staffing, applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- The event is open to the public, and a minimum attendance of 100 people is expected

- The event is over 4 hours in length taking place (for the most part) during daylight hours.
- The site meets PTBO H₂O Mobile Drinking Water Station requirements:
 - Located on a level surface.
 - Close to water source if using direct hookup option.
 - Easy access for tow vehicle.
 - Adequate clearance around the Peterborough Utilities Mobile Drinking Water Station for easy access to fountains/ faucets.
 - Relative close to the main event activities.
 - o If draining from grey water tank, positioned close to drain or ditch.

Fees

Peterborough Utilities operates the PTBO H_2O mobile drinking water station as a community service to promote the value of our safe, reliable drinking water. However, in consideration of our rate paying water customers, we do charge a nominal fee to cover operating costs. Costs vary depending on several factors, as described in the chart below.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is there a cost to use the Peterborough Utilities Mobile Drinking Water Station?

A fee is charged to help offset costs to operate the PTBO H₂O Mobile Drinking Water Station at the event.

Is the PTBO H₂O Mobile Drinking Water Station safe to use?

The PTBO H₂O Mobile Drinking Water Station is maintained in accordance with its operational guidelines and public health regulations. During events, sanitation and cleaning procedures are followed by the Peterborough Utilities representatives trained to operate the Peterborough Utilities Mobile Drinking Water Station.

How is water provided by the PTBO H₂O Mobile Drinking Water Station?

The PTBO H₂O Mobile Drinking Water Station is equipped with taps and fountains that receive water using one of two methods; direct-connect of bulk-fill. The chart below describes each method and what method may be better suited for your event.

Direct- connect	The PTBO H ₂ O Mobile Drinking Water Station receives its water at the event from a ³ / ₄ " water tap connected to the municipal water supply. Food grade hoses take water from the tap to the Mobile Drinking Water Station. Prior to hook up, the water source must be approved by Peterborough Utilities staff.	 Continuous supply of water. Lower booking fees. 	Placement restricted to 150 feet or less from water source (tap).
Bulk-fill	PTBO H ₂ O Mobile Drinking Water Station arrives at the event with its 1400- litre tank pre-filled with municipal tap water.	 Placement is not restricted by location of water source. 	 Higher booking fee. Limited to 1400 litres supply of water, and some time offsite is needed to re-fill.
